TERM AND CONDITIONS

1. Classes run according to the Rules of Dressage NZ
2. As this is a Training Series, Riders and Horses do not have to be registered with Equestrian Sports NZ

3. Section Definitions

MASTER CLASS

Riders 40 years and over. Horse may be of any grade.

FRESHMAN

Rider who has NEVER been placed first to third in any dressage competition (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory etc) or ever competed in open Graded Dressage.

GRADUATE

Rider who has not been placed (1st to 4th) more than three times in non-graded dressage (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory non-graded or ever been placed 1st to 4th in any open graded dressage (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory etc)
Open to riders who are not eligible for FRESHMAN or GRADUATE.
Horse to have had no more than five dressage starts (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory etc) before the first day of this series
(Please be honest)

PRIMARY

GREEN HORSE

Horses must be no higher than five dressage starts (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory etc) before the first day of this series
(Please be honest)

SECONDARY

Horses must be no higher than LEVEL 2 grade

TERTIARY

Open to any Horse/Rider combination.

4. Riders must ride no higher than Level 1 graded horses, except for Master Class, Secondary & Tertiary.
5. All tests may be commanded.
6. Ponies ineligible.
7. The draw will be adhered to. If you have any special requests, please advise with your entries, otherwise riders not appearing at their given times will be eliminated.
8. The Organisers and WEC disclaim any and all liability in the event of accident to rider, horse, spectator or property.
9. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
10. All horses on the grounds must be competing.
11. Breaches of Terms, Conditions and Rules may result in elimination or disqualification.
12. The Organisers reserve the right to alter prizes, and/or programme.
13. Random Gear Checks will be in operation. to avoid elimination, read the rules.
14. Each day will be held despite Rain, Hail or Snow!!!!
15. Tests sheets will be available after the final score is posted for each class. A stamped address envelope can be sent, or test sheets can be collected on the following competition day. We will have stamped envelopes for sale at \$1.00
16. Objections must be in writing, accompanied by \$30 within 30 minutes of class completion.
17. Any queries regarding scoring to be dealt with within 30 minutes of class completion or given placings will stand.

State the Topscore you wish to enter on your first entry form

- Topscore points will only count from time of Topscore entry (eg if entering Topscore on second day, first days points will not count).
- Rider/horse combinations entering more than one section (Freshman, Graduate, Primary, Green Horse, Secondary, Tertiary and Master Class) must nominate only **one** for section Topscore on first entry form.
- All Topscore winners must be present (mounted, unless otherwise stated) to be eligible to collect awards on final day.
