

Special Amateur Category Levels 1, 2 and 3 – Entry is restricted to riders and horses who have never competed at Medium or above and/or never placed 1st-4th in any registered event, North Island or National Championship competition at ANY level. Riders who qualify should enter the normal class but make a clear nomination on the entry form as an AR (Amateur Rider) and they will be eligible for a second result within the class.

Champions are awarded in each level, and will be decided by points over each class entered. Only one level is to be nominated per horse/rider combination, and only classes from that chosen level will count towards championship points.

Young Rider and Pony Champions will be decided on a points system. The Pony Championship is for ponies ridden by riders under 17 years of age. Young Rider Championship is for riders under 21 years of age not eligible for the Pony Championship. Points will be totalled up from each class entered for an overall score.

Pony Club team combination - Each pony club can submit a team of 4 riders (pony clubs can submit more than 1 team) and each riders points will be added to the teams for an overall score.

Team Combination – Team of any four riders submitted and each riders points will be added to the teams for an overall score.

Pony Club Championship – All pony club riders will be eligible for this championship. Each riders points will be added up from every class entered for an overall score.

POINTS PRIZES

Points will be awarded –

1 st	10 points	2 nd	9 points	3 rd	8 points
4 th	7 points	5 th	6 points	6 th	5 points

In the case of equality on points the rider with the highest % in classes where points were gained will be the winner.

EQUAL PLACINGS

There will be no equal placings in all classes.

If equal – highest total of Judges collective marks

If still equal – Highest total of co-efficient marks

If still equal – highest mark(s) for individual movement(s) shall be the winner

Freestyle Tests If two competitors have the same final total the one with the highest marks for Artistic Presentation will be the winner.

All Championships and Reserve will be awarded on Sunday after classes are finished so keep an eye on the score boards. All champions and reserves are required to be mounted and correctly attired for prize giving. Rosettes can be collected from the office after each class has finished.

All tests will be ridden in 20x60m arenas

Classes are limited to 30 riders, However if some classes are smaller and there is a higher demand for certain classes there will be a list and we will make some classes bigger.

***** Five minutes to talk to the judge *****

All classes with a * beside it allows you to have five minutes straight after your test to talk to the judge. Once you have completed your test, please stay in the arena and wait patiently by the judges car, This allows the next rider to ride around the arena keeping the classes running on time.

***** Saturday Night BBQ dinner *****

There will be a BBQ dinner held on Saturday night starting at 6.30pm. Tickets are \$20.00 per person and tickets should be booked and paid for with entries.
