WHAT IS A NON-JUMPERS CLASS?

These classes are for children aged 10 years and under who are not currently jumping. It is a great way to introduce riders to the ODE format, learning dressage tests and following a numbered obstacle course. The rider will complete their dressage test and go straight into the obstacle course – this means they will need to walk/watch the obstacle course before they ride. These classes will be run separately from the other classes of the ODE. The obstacle course will take place in the rodeo arena and. Armbands and Back-protectors are not compulsory.

DRESSAGE

Dressage test A is a standard dressage test out of the Pony Club Dressage Test Book (available from saddlery shops). The rules regarding whips and bits that can be used are in the dressage book. The dressage test may be called.

OBSTACLE COURSE

The obstacle course is a numbered course including stepping stones, bending poles, a maze, and much more. It will be judged on time and points (i.e. missing a bending pole or falling off the stepping stones will incur penalty points). A course plan will be placed on the outside of the ring you can walk the course before 9am or during breaks (you will not be allowed to walk it once the class begins).

PRIZES

The points from the dressage and the obstacle course will added together to give a final score. There will be ribbons awarded from 1st–5th.

RULES FOR NON JUMPERS:

Judges decision is final.

Dressage tests may be called.

Approved helmets must be worn at all times.

Back protectors and armbands are not compulsory.

Horses must not be tied to trucks – please use your specified yard. All muck & hay must be cleared from yards.
