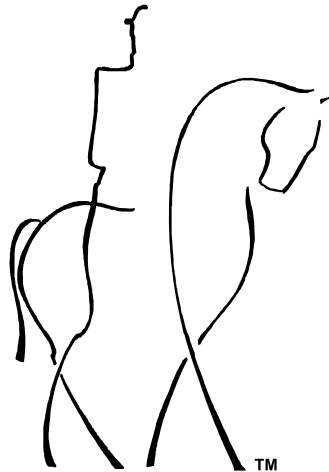

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DRESSAGE

1. Classes run according to the Rules of Equestrian Sports NZ
2. As this is a Training Series, Riders and Horses do not have to be registered with Equestrian Sports NZ
3. Section Definitions

| | |
|--------------|---|
| KINDERGARTEN | Riders on a lead rein, or not yet cantering. |
| JUNIOR | Rider who has NEVER been placed first to third in any dressage competition (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory etc) or ever competed in open Graded Dressage. |
| INTERMEDIATE | Rider who has NEVER been placed (1 st to 3 rd) in any dressage competition more than three times (Pony Club, Horse Trials, Non-Grading, Introductory non-graded) |
| SENIOR | Open to any rider/pony combination. Rider to be 16 years and under. |
| SPECIAL PONY | Rider 17 years and over, includes adults. |

- 4 All tests may be commanded.
5. The draw will be adhered to. If you have any special requests, please advise with your entries, otherwise riders not appearing at their given times will be eliminated.
6. The Organisers and WEC disclaim any and all liability in the event of accident to rider, horse, spectator or property.
7. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- 8 All ponies on the grounds must be competing.
- 9 Breaches of Terms, Conditions and Rules may result in elimination or disqualification.
- 10 The Organisers reserve the right to alter prizes, and/or programme.
- 11 Random Gear Checks will be in operation. to avoid elimination, read the rules.
- 12 Each day will be held despite Rain, Hail or Snow!!!!
- 13 Tests sheets will be available after the final score is posted for each class. A stamped address envelope can be sent, or test sheets can be collected on the following competition day. We will have stamped envelopes for sale at \$1.00
- 14 Objections must be in writing, accompanied by \$30 within 30 minutes of class completion.

SCORING FOR SHOW JUMPING

CTT Closest to Time

Competitors will compete against an unpublished time. Closest to the time wins. An indication of the TIME ALLOWED will be on the COURSE PLAN.

The actual unpublished time will be set by the judge.

This is NOT a speed class

TAM3 Table A Mixed #3

A competition not against the clock with a time allowed but in the event of equality of penalties for 1st place, there will be a jump off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties in the first round.

ENTRIES FOR DRESSAGE AND SHOW JUMPING

- Incorrect, late or entries received without full fees will not be accepted.
- No phone, fax or e-mail entries accepted.
- Dressage draw will be on www.horses.net.nz If you require your draw by mail please forward a SAE with your entry form. There will be no draw for the show jumping.
- Show jumping entries before the day MAY ride ahead of entries on the day. Blackboard system will operate for all riders.
- NO REFUNDS will be given on scratching and no entries will be transferred to the next days competition.
- Ground Fee \$5.00 per horse, current WEC Members ground fee \$3.00 per horse.
- Entry Fee - Dressage \$6.00 per class, Show jumping \$6.00 per class
- Show jumping entries will be accepted on the day at \$10.00 per class.
